

It was a pleasure to judge at this well-run show; thank you to both the committee and exhibitors. I found the usual complaint is still around - many dogs lacking front extension; only breeders and instructors at seminars are in a position to do anything about this, so please spend time on this important part of the afghan makeup, I found dentition mixed; many dirty teeth and a couple with level bites, although somewhat rare it is of course acceptable; having said that I was delighted with my main winners.

Vet dog PASHTARI THE PRIEST OF LOVE, 7yr old blk/mask gold all male, good head, dark eye, good shoulder and spring of rib good depth of chest, balanced rear, moved well.

MPD, AFFIETAR GLEN MARAGAN, blk/mask gold, very raw baby at 6mths, when I eventually fought my way through the Beatle hair style and monkey whiskers there was a nice head, dark eye good dentition good shoulder & upper arm, good angles and ring tail.

PD, RHAZMAKH NOW IS THE TYME FOR BONDOR, self/mask cream dog, dark eye, well off for bone, deep chest, good angles, good tail set, once settled showed good stride **BPD**.

Junior, 1<sup>st</sup> PASHTARI LORD BYRON, blk & cream dog, nice head on this boy, and again dark eye, balanced angles for/aft good fall away, ring tail and nice movement.

2<sup>nd</sup> AGHA DJARI'S NAVAJO AT HARLEXTAN, upstanding brindle, dark eye good in outline and the promise of springy movement once settled, good angles and ring tail; bit of a handful for his handler.

Yearling, 1<sup>st</sup> SHIMALMA ITALIAN SUNSET, shaded deep gold, self-masked super head, correct shoulder and return, deep chest, well ribbed back, balanced rear, good fall away, tail set and ring tail, real showman, moved with reach and drive **CC & BIS**

2<sup>nd</sup> GILARI RED DIAMOND at TAZKINDI nice red dog who appeals, lovely head, good eye, good shoulder deep chest, balanced rear; moved with good reach and drive

3<sup>rd</sup> SHIMALMA RUM RUNNER

Maiden, 1<sup>st</sup> PRISONER OF LOVE, 14 mth shaded gold, med size boy, nice head, good angles, correct fall away, ring tail still looks very much a baby

Novice, 1<sup>st</sup> RHAZMAKH NOW IS THE TYME BONDOR

Special Beginners, 1<sup>st</sup> KHAMIS AEQUITAS AT EWEYISSKA, self /mask cream good pigment, balanced head, nice depth good rear angles, moved much better in this class.

Graduate, 1<sup>st</sup> WAY UP IMPERIO AT BICHOUX JW, shaded gold chunky boy, balanced head, dark eye, good angles, moved well

2<sup>nd</sup> CLOUDSIDE FLASH HEART, blk/crm, finer all through, good angles front and rear, lean head, moved well.

Post Graduate, 1<sup>st</sup> DRISHAUN IT AINT WHAT YOU DO, lovely upstanding gold scores in head; dark eye, good shoulder & return, great depth of chest, and spring of rib, balanced rear; fall away and set to tail, comes into his own on the move; great extension drive and spring **RCC**

2<sup>nd</sup> ZILBEC ZANTHUS self-mask cream, nice dark eye, lovely head good length of neck, balanced all through, ringtail and moved well, nice dog.

Mid Limit, 1<sup>st</sup> THENDARA FAIT ACCOMPLI, impressive solid black absolutely balanced all through strength without coarseness, good shoulder and return, great depth, balanced rear good head with darkest of eyes, good mover

2<sup>nd</sup> ARUSHKHAN DANCIN IN MY HEART AT AMBESHAN JW, shaded gold, lovely head, dark eye, good shoulder and depth, moved well with verve

Limit, 1st SYRDARYA CUSTARD CREAM, self-masked gold boy I have done well for before, good head, nice length of neck, great front; good shoulder and return; nice spring of rib, ring tail well-presented coat, sadly today not moving as I know he can

2nd litter brother to 1 SYRDARYA GINGER NUT similar comments apply smaller frame, but none the less balanced, would like more finish to his coat; good movement

3rd JAVIDAN KISS THE SKY OVER TARAKHI,

OPEN, 1ST CH GARAMOND SUNBERRY, blk/crm dog with lovely head & eye, well ribbed back, balanced front & rear good fall away and ring tail, worthy champion.
