Veteran Dog: (4)

1st – Millward & Mottershaw's MULTI CH. TAHKIRA LIKE IT LIKE THAT (Imp Aus), good head, dark eye and low set ears, long neck, well laid shoulder, good body condition with fair spring of rib, deep chest, level topline, well bent muscled quarters, moved well in all directions, Res. CC, Res. BIS, & Best Veteran in Show.

2nd – Gardner's JAVIDAN BAD BOY BOOGIE, good head with dark eye, low set ears, good length of neck, well laid shoulder, level topline, well bodied with a deep chest, well bent muscled quarters, good mover.

3rd – Cannon;s MULTI CH. CALAMUS MEDIATOR (Imp) JW.

Puppy Dog: (5)

1st – Lancashire & O'Donnell's DRISHAUN FAIR AS A LILY, good head with dark eye, long neck, well laid shoulder, good body and ribs for age, well bent quarters, good steady mover in all directions for a pup, BPIS.

2nd – Lancashire & O'Donnell's DRISHAUN STAR AMONG LILIES, litter brother to winner, much the same remarks apply, slightly longer cast, good head with dark eye, long neck, well laid shoulder, good body for age, moderate rear angulation, moved steady.

3rd – Gardner's DRISHAUN SAID TIGER TO LILY.

Junior Dog: (3, 1abs)

1st – Hurl, Nisbet & Forrester's ZANDAHAR ZCUSE ME MISTER, gave his handler a hard time, nice head with dark eye, long neck, well laid shoulder, good body for age, well bent muscled quarters, moved steady when settled.

2nd – Smithson & Mitchell's ZANDAHAR ZPLOSIVE STORM, litter brother to first, much the same remarks, longer cast than brother, liked his head, neck and topline, good body and quarters, with a bit more schooling, he will settle in movement.

Yearling Dog: (9, 3abs)

1st – Churchill's JONECA INFERNO UNDER AFRIKAMOON, nice dog with good head and dark eye, long neck, well laid shoulder, well bodied with level topline, deep chest, well bent muscled quarters, moved well when settled.

2nd – Reed's CLOUDSIDE SUNSTRIKE JW, another nice dog, liked his head, dark eye and long neck, well laid shoulder with deep chest and level topline, good quarters, moved steady.

3rd – McCormack's TULAK DESPICABLE ME.

Maiden Dog: (2)

1st – Lancashire & O'Donnell's DRISHAUN PICTURES OF LILY, typical pup who played his handler up, good head with dark eye, good length of neck, well placed shoulder, good topline and body for age, good quarters, moved steady when settled.

2nd – Moyes BRYELIS REBEL HEART, another pup who played his handler up, nice head, neck and topline, good body for age, good quarters, needs to settle in movement.

Novice Dog: (6)

1st – Lancashire & O'Donnell's DRISHAUN FAIR AS A LILY.

2nd – Lancashire & O'Donnell's DRISHAUN STAR AMONG LILIES.

3RD – Lancashire & O'Donnell's DRISHAUN PICTURES OF LILY.

Spec. Beginners Dogs: (1)

1st – Grant-Thomas's KOUROS TELL ME ON A SUNDAY (Imp Ita), nice head, neck and topline, well laid shoulder, deep chest, good body and quarters, would benefit from running at slower pace.

Graduate Dog: (5,1abs)

1st – James's SITANA AAG TOOFAN, well balanced head with dark eye, long neck, well laid shoulder, good topline and ribs, deep chest, well bent muscled quarters, good mover.

2nd – Bovey's SITANA BARISA TOOFAN KARIANCA, litter brother with good head, neck and shoulder placement, dark eye, deep chest, good body condition and quarters, another good mover.

3rd – Abrey's KARAGEZ TAME THE WORLD (Imp Rus).

Post Grad. Dog: (9,2abs)

1st – Gorman & Latimer's AFFIETAR GLEN SHIEL AT ZHAROOK, I see this dog is sired by the CC winner who has passed on many of his attributes, lovely head with dark eye, low set ears, well placed shoulder, level topline, deep chest, fair spring of rib, well bent muscled quarters, good mover.

2nd – Seamarks & Nemoto's SAYADENA NORTHERN LIGHTS (Imp Bel), nice head with dark eye, good shoulder, topline and body, deep chest, fair spring of rib, good quarters, moved well.

3rd – Langer's KHAMIS HUCKLEBERRY JW.

Mid Limit Dog: (5,2abs)

1st – Hall's SAXONMILL BURR BURR CHAN AT GARAMOND, good head with dark eye, long neck, well laid shoulder, level topline, deep chest, good body with fair spring of rib, well bent muscled quarters, moved well in all directions.

2nd – Langer's KHAMIS PACIFIC TIGER JW, liked his head, length of neck and shoulder placement, well bodied with a deep chest and fair spring of rib, well bent muscled quarters, sound mover.

3rd – Garnder's DRISHAUN IT AIN'T WHAT YOU DO.

Limit Dog: (13,3abs)

1st & 2nd are of different types, however, both fit the standard well.

1st – Bloor's PASHTARI LORD BURON, good head with dark eye, well laid shoulder, good topline, deep chest with fair spring of rib, good body condition, well bent muscled quarters, good mover.

2nd – Parsell-Beanland's AGHA DJARI'S NAVAJO AT HARLEXTAN (Imp Deu), another nice dog, liked his head, neck and topline, dark eye, well laid shoulder, good body condition with a fair spring of rib, well bent muscled quarters, another good mover.

3rd – Cullen's SYRDARYA TOFFY POP AT EWEYISSKA.

Open Dog: (7)

1st – Latimer's CH. JEREMIAH DE KOULANGAR AT ZHAROOK JW (Imp Fra), good head with a dark eye and low set ears, long neck, well laid shoulder, level topline, well bodied with deep chest and fair spring of rib, well bent muscled quarters, good mover in all directions, CC, BOB & BIS.

2nd – Virgo & Hicks AM CH. SUNI ASIA WISH UPON A STAR BY SUMAHARI JW ShCEx (Imp USA), good head, neck and topline dark eye, deep chest with fair spring of rib, well bent muscled quarters, moved well in all directions.

3rd – Hall's CH. DEVANMARN IT'S A KIND OF MAJIC SAXONMILL.
