The current state of the nation's health caused the Association, led by our Rescue Officer, to put together a few useful suggestions which could help in the event of any emergency that might befall either now or in the future.

The Association now has an Emergency Form which can be found on our website www.ahaonline.co.uk In the very unlikely event that you had to leave afghans in your home this would help emergency services and whoever was authorised to look after them in your absence.

All these tips are of course only suggestions and you would need to consider them in the light of your own circumstances and security.

- Put up a notice to say 'Keep All Doors Closed'
- Arrange for a relative/neighbour/friend to have access to your afghans in an emergency together with a copy of the Emergency Form.
- Make sure all hounds have collars on. For a stranger to tell them apart colour code their collar to their name on the Emergency Form.
- Make sure all leads, food, medicine etc is easily found in one place.
- Confine dogs safely and leave treats if possible near a front door or gate for anyone entering to use.

We are sure that you will have other ideas and hope these suggestions may be of use.
